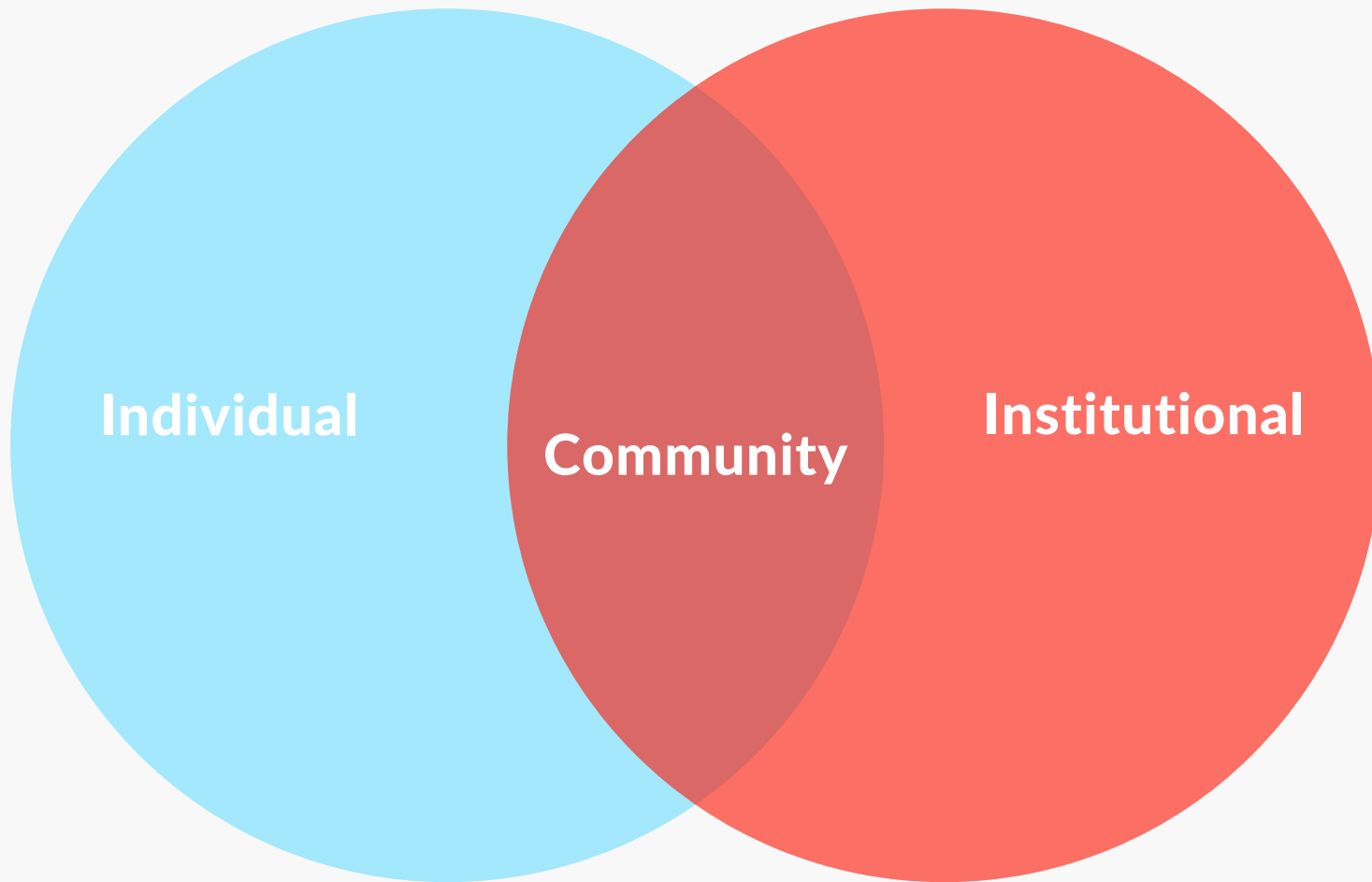

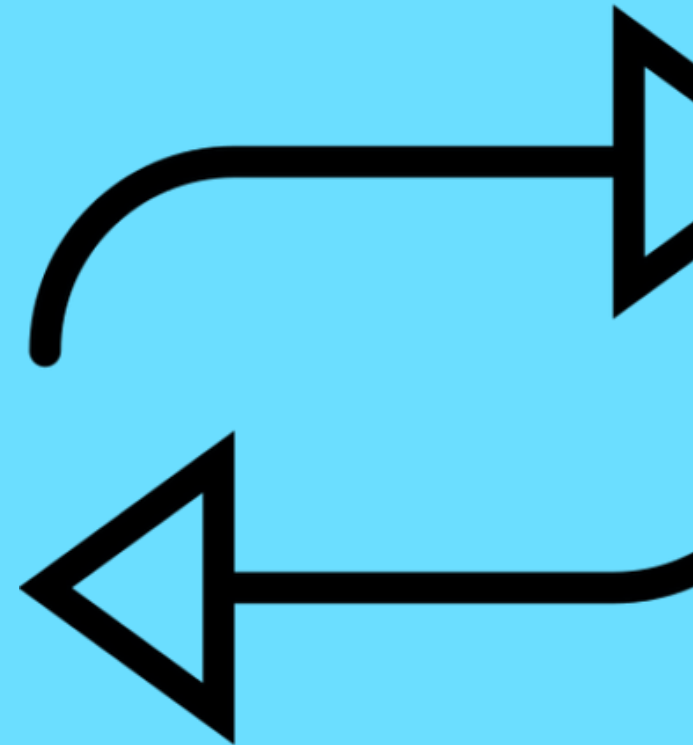

Has a stake in a successful outcome

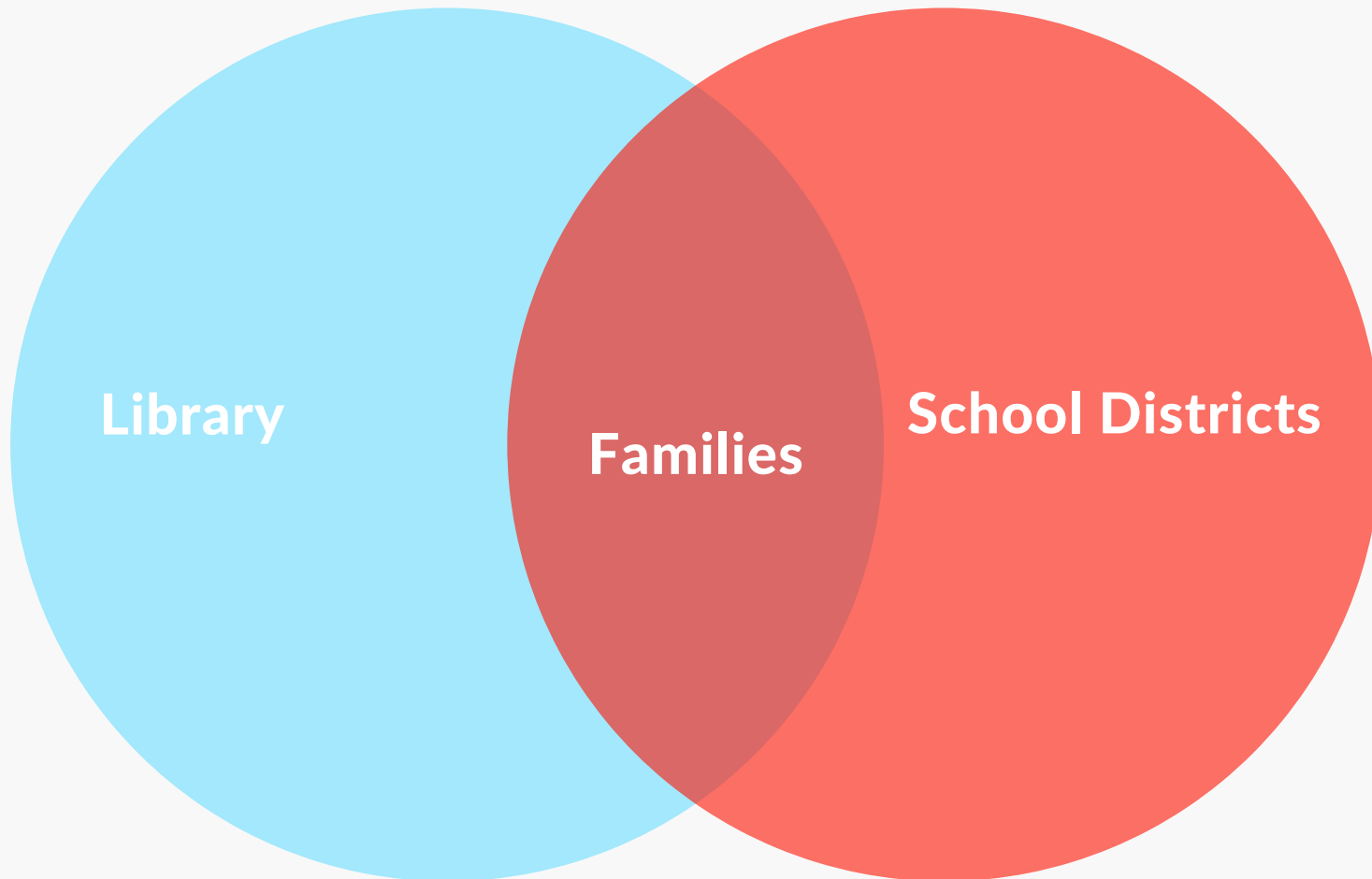
